The following matters were voted upon at the Annual Meeting of Shareholders of Quaterra Resources Inc. (the "Company") held on June 23, 2016 in Vancouver, B.C. Each of the matters is described in greater detail in the 2016 Notice of Annual General Meeting of Shareholders and Information Circular dated May 16, 2016.

1. Number of Directors

The number of Directors to be elected at the Meeting for the ensuing year was set at five. The results were as follows:
